PHIS' National Honor Society Recycling Project



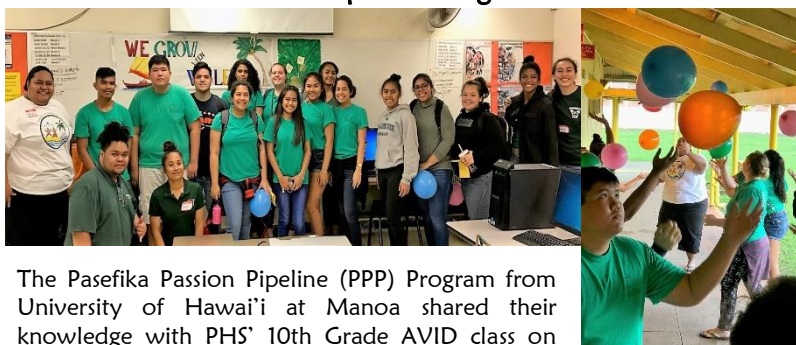

Pasefika Passion Pipeline Program Visits AVID



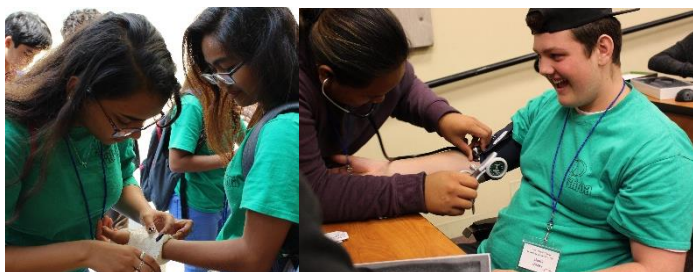
