AVID Excursion May 2018



On Friday, April 20, the rainfall came to a halt, as 94 AVID Program students in grades 7 to 12 went on a field trip that took them to the University of Hawaii at Hilo's Panaewa Agriculture Farm, the College Fair, and a picnic lunch at Liliuokalani Park.

When visiting the Panaewa Agriculture Farm, students were hosted by Dr. Lissa Tsutsumi and Mr.

Britton Cole. Students listened to a presentation about the bee hives and learned about how the hives are a source of funding for Ag students through a program partnership with Chef Alan Wong. Students saw parts of the 110-acre farm when they took a 45-minute walking tour to see the orchards, livestock, and the bee hives, and were able to sample fresh honey with crackers!

AVID students were impressed by the hands-on opportunities that the farm provides to students in the College of Agriculture. Presenters did an excellent job of explaining that the farm is where academics and real-life meet.

The next stop was the College Fair held at the Kamehameha Schools Hawaii campus gym. Students from East Hawaii middle and high schools mingled, while visiting representatives from over 50 colleges and universities. A lot of interesting and valuable information was shared at this event.



The day ended with lunch at Liliuokalani Park, as students feasted on the Pahoia School Poke Bowl Special from Suisan Fish Market, ono grinds from Isle's Café, or specially made home lunches. The beauty and serenity of the park, along with the surrounding ocean, was enjoyed by all.
