Non-DOE Electronic Devices Policy

Student may have a personal electronic device on their person while school is in session from Monday through Friday. Student may use their personal electronic devices appropriately before school, during recess, during lunch and after school. Student's personal electronic devices may be used for appropriate activities such as doing homework, research, listening to music (with earphones) or playing games, etc.

However, it is strongly recommended that students secure all personal electronic devices at home or in their car. Pahoa High & Intermediate or its representatives will not assume responsibility for student's personal devices that are lost, stolen, damaged and/or confiscated.

Personal Electronic Devices Use in the Classroom:

The operation, display and use of any personal electronic device by a student during class time Monday through Friday is expressly prohibited. The operation, display, and use of a personal electronic device during instructional periods will result in the immediate confiscation of that device. The following process will be adhered to:

- 1) Student may pick up the device from the front office the first time.**
- 2) Parent will pick up the device from the front office the second time and all other times after.**
- 3) Disciplinary action for any continued inappropriate use after the second time**
