### Healthy Recipes:

#### White Peppermint Snowball Cookies

**Ingredients:** 1 (16.5 oz) package refrigerated sugar cookie dough;  
¼ cup plus 2 tbsp. crushed hard peppermint candies; ¾ cup  
powdered sugar, divided.

#### Directions:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Cut sugar dough into 8 pieces.  
Combine the dough pieces, ¼ cup crush crushed hard peppermint  
candies, and ½ cup powdered sugar in a bowl or electric mixer.  
Let the mixture chill in the refrigerator for 30 minutes. Coat hands  
in flour and roll chilled dough into ½ inch diameter balls. Place  
the balls 2 inches apart on parchment paper-lined baking sheets.  
Bake for 9-10 minutes or until set. Cool Cookies slightly on cooling  
rack. While cookies are still warm sprinkle the tops with ¼ cup  
powdered sugar and 2 tablespoons crush hard peppermint candies.
