Digestive Health Recipes: Easy Tsukemono

Ingredients: 1 medium to large head cabbage cut into bit size pieces; 1 cup white sugar; 1/2 cup Japanese vinegar; 3/4 cup water; 2 TBSP Hawaiian salt

Directions: Heat to dissolved sugar and salt. Do not cool, pour over cut up cabbage. Place a **plate** over it, and weight it down. When cooled, put it in containers and refrigerate.

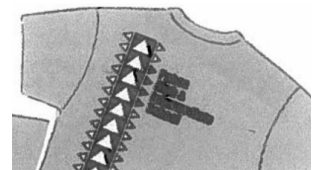
